



CSA Game Reporting Procedures Fall 2017



I CAN do this! Quick & Easy Game Reporting Cheat Sheet

Center Referee is responsible for reporting the score in two places:

1. **Game Officials** – maintain a permanent records of all games worked
2. **GotSoccer** – your score is updated on the CSA website for teams, coaches, parents & referees to see.

TIP: Print a copy of your game assignments before going to the fields

1) GotSoccer Score Reporting

Report Scores - Between/After Games using your smart phone/tablet

Download the GotSoccer App from the App Store

“Event Scoring”

League Name	League Prefix Refer to game #	Event ID #	PIN #
Champions League	CCL	60507	2777
Centennial League	CENT	60509	2777
Front Range League	FRL	60508	2777
Secondary League A	SLA	60525	2777
Secondary League B	SLB	60526	2777
Mountain Region League	MRL	60523	2777

- Enter Event ID #
- Enter PIN # and hit “Go”
- Enter Game # (enter numbers only, no letters/no prefix)
- Tap your screen on the “H or “A” box, and score entry boxes will drop down
- Enter scores in the “appropriate boxes”, and click save.

When you get home, take out your data wallet & update Game Officials.

2) Game Officials – After Games Game Reporting

Easy Stuff

Log into your GameOfficials.net account

Go to “After Games” on the Main Menu

“Select Date”

“Click on Game Number”

A window will appear – Enter Score for home & away!

I can't find my games! Help!

Use the “Change Identity” feature, and switch to the appropriate assignor group

Note: The CRA Group (Colorado Referee Administration) is the learning/testing center only. Assignments do not exist in the CRA Group)

What if I issued a yellow card, red card, had a player injury, had a dangerous sprinkler head on the field, dismissed a coach, need to report poor touchline behavior, inclement weather, or had a great day & want to share that with somebody? We want to hear about it – because we care, and want to make Colorado soccer fields a great place to be.

After reporting the score, and saving it – You are still in “After Games”, look on the right hand side of your screen for “Incident Reports”

“Click to Add A New Incident Report”

Report Incident: - select one type

Time of Incident – select

Reason: - Select one

Don't know which one to select? Reference the 7 & 7

Team Name – Select

Uniform Number , if applicable, Enter
Roster/Pass #, if applicable (found on CSA player pass)

Remember – Game Reports = Game Pay!

Report within 24 hours of your games!

If you don't provide details of incidents on the fields we can't follow up.
