**Prior to leaving for the field – please print a copy of your final assignment schedule for reference at the fields!**

### Game Day Guidelines:

- Arrive a minimum of 45 minutes prior to kickoff of your first game.
- Check in at REFEREE Headquarters Northeast corner of pod 2 above field 12. Do not go directly to the field assigned. Center Referees must pick up game card. Assistant Referees must be confirmed on site.

### Game card and Player Pass procedures –

- 1) Tournament is using pre-printed GotSoccer game cards with rosters on the cards. GUEST PLAYER ROSTERS WILL BE PRESENTED BY TEAMS OR GUEST PLAYERS WILL HAVE BEEN MANUALLY ADDED TO CARD PRIOR TO GAMES
- 2) Referee can give completed game card to Field Marshal OR place in a visible spot for pickup during next game.
- 3) The Referee Site coordinators will pick up the cards for delivery to tournament headquarters verification and scoring.
- 4) Brief information for cautions/send-offs go on the back of the game card.
- 5) Supplemental reports must be completed in [www.gameofficials.net](http://www.gameofficials.net) AFTER GAMES by the end of the tournament.

**Do ONLY a quick safety check prior to starting the game.**

REMEMBER -- Completed game cards will be picked up by Referee staff. It is imperative that we keep the games running on time!

Rosters and passes were approved at team check in. The teams have been instructed to provide passes if needed for sendoffs

**REFEREES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCURATELY COMPLETING GAME CARDS AND/OR RETURNING PASSES TO THE TEAMS AFTER THE GAME.**

### Substitutions:

In U11/U12 Teams are allowed unlimited substitutions at any stoppage of play. Players must be ready at substitution opportunity. In U13/U14, prior to throw-in, by throwing team (or by non-throwing if both are subbing), prior to a goal kick, after a goal, after an injury, or a cautioned player may be substituted if the team requests.

### Game Reports / Referee Payments:

**Game reporting is the final step of your job. Referees who do not submit game scores/reports will not be paid.**

Referee payment is the responsibility of Colorado Shoot Out Soccer Tournament and Trebol Soccer Club. Reporting is only done through GameOfficials.net Referees who report games in GameOfficials.net in a timely fashion will receive payment via GoPay at the next pay date. Pay dates are published on the GameOfficials.net home page.

If you have a problem, tell the on-site referee mentor/coordinator. If you have questions, contact your assignor.
